## CARES Act (Coronavirus ) Funding Oversight

- Prime recipients are required to submit quarterly financial progress reports
  - 1<sup>st</sup> reporting period available for data entry on 9/1/20.

### Prime Recipient Roles

- Treasury OIG Financial Report utilizes OLDC which is a role-based system
  - Editor initialize, edit and save form
  - Submitter reviews form and submits to Treasury OIG for approval


## Accessing the CARES Act Financial Progress Report


